PHOTOGRAPHY/FILMING NOTIFICATION - TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PERMISSION

Photography and Filming for Personal Use

- 1. Amateur photography and filming for personal use are permitted in the common areas of Alimos Marina, excluding restricted-access areas (e.g., administrative offices, technical facilities, security zones).
- 2. Photography or filming of boats, owners, crews, and visitors is allowed only with their explicit consent.
- 3. The use of drones for personal or amateur purposes is prohibited without prior approval from the Management of Alimos Marina and in accordance with the applicable legislation of the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA).
- 4. Material from amateur photography and filming may not be used for commercial purposes or reproduced in any print or electronic medium without the approval of the Management of Alimos Marina.

Photography and Filming for Professional and Commercial Purposes

- 1. Professional photography and filming for commercial, advertising, tourism, or artistic purposes are allowed only with prior approval from the Management of Alimos Marina
- 2. Interested parties must submit a formal request at least 10 working days before the scheduled date of the activity. The request should be sent to newalimosmarina@ellaktor.com including:
 - o A detailed description of the purpose and type of photography or filming.
 - o Title of the production ("Project").
 - o Description of the equipment to be used and the number of vehicles requiring entry permits.
 - o Number of individuals involved (including agents, actors, and crew).
 - o Specific areas to be used.
 - o Estimated duration of the activity, proposed filming date(s), locations, and schedules.
 - o Name of the broadcast/publication/digital organization.
 - o Broadcast/publication dates.
 - o Any specific needs (e.g., access to security areas, use of electricity, set installations etc.).
- 3. The Management of Alimos Marina reserves the right to approve or reject the request and to establish:

- o Terms and conditions for conducting the photography/filming, which are detailed here: (link)
- o Possible charges for the use of spaces or services.
- 4. Photography or filming in areas of special interest (e.g., boats, security facilities) is prohibited without specific permission.

Photography and Filming Events

- Photography and filming of events (commercial, corporate, social, or cultural) held within Alimos Marina are allowed only with prior approval from the Marina Management. The approval is valid exclusively for the purpose described in the relevant request submitted by the organizer(s).
- 2. Organizers must submit a relevant request at least 10 working days before the desired event date, including full details of the event and its photography/filming requirements. The request must include:
 - o A description of the event and its purpose.
 - o The number and type of photography/filming crews, number of vehicles requiring entry permits, and the estimated number of people involved/attending the event.
 - o Locations for equipment setup (cameras, lights, etc.).
 - o The estimated duration of the event.
- 3. The use of drones or specialized filming equipment during events is permitted only with special permission from the Management and in compliance with CAA regulations.
- 4. The Management of Alimos Marina reserves the right to set additional conditions to ensure the smooth conduct of the event, safeguarding the operation and safety of the Marina.
- 5. Regarding photography or filming of individuals conducted as part of events or other activities on the premises of Alimos Marina, and upon relevant request and under the responsibility of the designated organizer, the organizer must ensure the implementation of appropriate organizational and technical measures to protect personal data being processed. The organizer must also fulfill all obligations as the data controller (informing individuals, obtaining consent for material use, protecting subject rights, anonymization), in compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR 2016/679/EU) and Greek legislation (Law 4624/2019).

Use of Photographic or Cinematographic Material

- The use of photographic or cinematographic material from the premises of Alimos Marina for third-party professional purposes and its publication in print, advertising campaigns, etc., is allowed only with the written consent of the Management of Alimos Marina and after the issuance of a special permit, in accordance with the Terms and Conditions agreed upon by the Permit Holder.
- 2. Alimos Marina retains the intellectual property rights of the photographic and cinematographic material from specific Projects produced within its premises under a license granted by the Marina Management. Attribution of the material's origin and its creator is mandatory. It is emphasized that such material ("Material") may not be published or reproduced without prior approval from the Management of Alimos Marina.

Distribution of brochures/leaflets

The distribution of brochures/leaflets or printed promotional material within Alimos Marina is prohibited without prior written consent from the Administration Office.

Compliance with Terms and Sanctions

In case of non-compliance with the above terms:

- Photography, filming, or events will be immediately terminated.
- The Management of Alimos Marina retains its legal rights and may refuse the use of facilities for future activities.
