

## **PHOTOGRAPHY/FILMING NOTIFICATION - TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PERMIT**

### **Photography and Filming for Personal Use**

1. Amateur photography and filming for personal use are allowed in the public areas of Alimos Marina, except in restricted access areas (e.g., administrative offices, technical facilities, security zones).
2. Photography or filming of boats, owners, crews, and visitors is allowed only with their explicit consent.
3. The use of drones for personal or amateur purposes is prohibited without prior approval from the Management of Alimos Marina and in accordance with the relevant legislation of the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA).
4. Material from amateur photography and filming may not be used for commercial purposes or reproduced in any print or electronic medium without the approval of the Management of Alimos Marina.

### **Photography and Filming for Professional and Commercial Purposes**

1. Professional photography and filming for commercial, advertising, tourism, or artistic purposes are allowed only with the approval of the Management of Alimos Marina.
2. Interested parties must submit a formal request at least 10 working days before the scheduled date of the activity. The request should be sent to [NewAlimosMarina\\_Marketing@Ellaktor.com](mailto:NewAlimosMarina_Marketing@Ellaktor.com) and include:
  - o A detailed description of the purpose and type of photography or filming.
  - o Production title ("Project").
  - o Description of the equipment to be used and the number of vehicles for which entry permits are required.
  - o Number of people involved (including agents, actors, and crew). Specific areas to be used.
  - o Estimated duration of the activity, proposed filming dates, locations, and schedules.
  - o Name of the broadcast/publication/digital organization.
  - o Broadcast/publication dates.
  - o Any special requirements (e.g., access to security areas, use of electricity, set construction, etc.).
3. The Management of Alimos Marina reserves the right to approve or reject the request and to establish:
  - o Terms and conditions for conducting the photography/filming,
  - o Any applicable charges for using spaces or services.
4. Photography or filming in special interest areas (e.g., boats, security installations) is prohibited without special permission.

## **Photography and Filming Events**

1. Photography and filming of events (commercial, corporate, social, or cultural) held within Alimos Marina are allowed only with the approval of the Marina Management. The approval is valid only for the purpose described in the related request from the organizer(s).
2. Organizers must submit a relevant request at least 10 working days before the desired event date with complete details of the event and photography/filming requirements. The request should include:
  - o Description of the event and its purpose.
  - o Number and type of photography/filming crews, number of vehicles for which entry permits are required, and the estimated number of people involved/attending the event.
  - o Locations for equipment installation (cameras, lights, etc.).
  - o Estimated duration of the event.
3. The use of drones or special filming equipment during events is allowed only with the special permission from the Management and in compliance with CAA regulations.
4. The Management of Alimos Marina reserves the right to set additional conditions for the smooth conduct of the event, ensuring the operation and safety of the Marina.
5. Regarding photography or filming of individuals during events or other activities at Alimos Marina, and following a relevant request and the responsibility of a designated organizer, the organizer must ensure the adoption of appropriate organizational and technical measures for the protection of personal data subject to processing and comply with all obligations as the data controller (informing individuals, obtaining consent for material use, protecting rights, anonymization), in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR 2016/679/EU) and Greek legislation (Law 4624/2019).

## **Use of Photographic or Cinematographic Material**

1. The use of photographic or cinematographic material from the premises of Alimos Marina for third-party commercial purposes and its publication in print, advertising campaigns, etc., is allowed only with the written consent of the Management of Alimos Marina and after receiving a special permit, in accordance with the Terms and Conditions agreed upon by the Permit Holder.
2. Alimos Marina retains the intellectual property rights of the photographic and cinematographic material of a specific Project produced in the Marina premises under the permission of the Marina Management. The origin of the material and its creator must be acknowledged. It is emphasized that such material ("Material") may not be published or reproduced without the prior approval of the Management of Alimos Marina.

### **Distribution of Flyers**

The distribution of flyers or printed advertising material within Alimos Marina is prohibited without prior written consent from the Management Office.

### **Compliance with Terms and Sanctions**

In case of non-compliance with the above terms:

- The photography, filming, or event will be immediately interrupted.
- The Management of Alimos Marina retains its legal rights and may refuse the use of facilities for future activities.

### **Terms and Conditions**

1. Any permit for taking photographs and/or video recordings at the premises of Alimos Marina is granted exclusively for the Project and for no other purpose.
2. Alimos Marina acknowledges that all intellectual property rights in the Project and the photographs and/or video recordings of its premises are the exclusive property of the Permit Holder, provided that the Permit Holder obtains written consent from the Marina Management before using the Material for any purpose other than the Project.
3. The Permit Holder guarantees and declares that the Project and the use of its Material will comply with all applicable laws and regulations, including, but not limited to, the Regulations of Alimos Marina, GDPR, and Law 4624/2019. The Permit Holder will not photograph/film employees or visitors of Alimos Marina without obtaining the explicit consent of these individuals. Furthermore, the Permit Holder ensures that the Project and its use of the Material will not expose, directly or indirectly, either through their actions or the actions of their employees or agents, Alimos Marina to any adverse action from any supervisory or regulatory authorities.
4. The Permit Holder will obtain and maintain all necessary permits and approvals from the competent authorities for the Project.
5. During the use of the Material, the Permit Holder:
  - a. must not use the Material for any purpose other than the Project,
  - b. must not create the impression that Alimos Marina supports any product or service or that the Material comes from any source other than Alimos Marina,

- c. The Permit Holder will provide Alimos Marina with a copy of the completed Project. If Alimos Marina intends to use a copy of the Project or part of it for publicity or marketing purposes, it will seek written consent from the Permit Holder.
6. The Permit Holder confirms that they have read and understood the attached Terms and Conditions and agree to be bound by them.
  7. The Permit Holder agrees to fully indemnify and hold harmless Alimos Marina and its representatives from any claims, demands, penalties, losses, damages, costs, and expenses (including reasonable legal fees) of any kind, including, without limitation, death, injury, loss, and/or damage arising directly or indirectly from or in connection with the Permit Holder or its representatives:
    - a. the use of the premises of Alimos Marina,
    - b. transmission and/or publication of the Project and/or use of the Material, including cases where such transmission, publication, or use violates any applicable laws or regulations,
    - c. violation of third-party intellectual property rights and/or personal data rights of third parties, or
    - d. non-compliance with these Terms and Conditions.
  8. The Permit Holder may not assign or transfer their rights or obligations under these Terms and Conditions, in whole or in part, without prior written consent from Alimos Marina.
  9. These Terms and Conditions are governed by Greek law, and all disputes arising from or in connection with this agreement will be resolved by the courts of Athens/Piraeus.
